Solo and ensemble – 18 groups performed, and 6 groups qualified for states on March 14<sup>th</sup> at Chippewa Valley again. Pep band had a nice season.

- 1. Festival most groups have one bus, symphony will have two busses. Heather is working on the bus chaperones. They discussed moving the instruments to festival. The 8<sup>th</sup> graders and the symphony band will be competing on Friday, Feb 28<sup>th</sup> and the 7<sup>th</sup> graders and wind ensemble will compete on Saturday, Feb 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. Fundraisers
  - Century Resources March 12<sup>th</sup> March 23<sup>rd</sup> We will be selling "popcorn and blooms" books. Both are non-perishable items.
- 3. Band Banquet Rachel sent the information using Crystal Gardens for the possible location for the band banquet.
  - 5/18-5/21 are still available at Crystal Gardens.
  - \$600 deposit is required ASAP to reserve the date (no hall rental fee, per person charge only)
  - No later than two weeks prior they need a head count we can post ticket sales on Send Money to School ASAP
  - \$12 our cost per person gets us the following:
  - Venue from 4pm-11pm (if needed, she's flexible on times)
  - Tables covered & decorated (we can bring our own centerpieces)
