Agenda Items

1. MMB 2020 and COVID-19

The number one priority is student safety. For the most part, they have been inside for several months.

Timeline – the document has been sent to administration for approval. Would like to have a parent to serve as an advisor if they are in the medical field.

Band camp – same week – will be from 9a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be a schedule so, there may be a staggered schedule for the hours that the students will be expected to be in attendance. At 93 students, we are at the max of the size we can have outdoors.

This will be outside – the building will have limited access. Keep in the shade as much as possible. Looking for tents. Hydration will be key – ½ gallon to a gallon per kid. The student's names must be on there.

Will use stadium bathrooms. 30 minutes on, 5 minutes off. 15 minutes off every 2 hours.

Parents/volunteers – taking temperatures, prescreening the kids, masks/cloth face coverings

Masks/face coverings must be worn by students, staff and volunteers at all times (unless the activity does not allow for it) i.e. playing an instrument.

Don't necessarily want medical grade masks, or the single use, ideally a cloth covering, i.e. a bandana that can be washed regularly

Thermometers – Mr. Mufarreh is ordering a thermometer. Need to have a google form that the students will have to fill out each morning before practice. Will need to get a few additional thermometers, cleaning supplies, hand sanitizer, single use latex gloves, etc

Large equipment – will stay at the school. All other instruments will be taken home.

Lunches will be staggered into two groups – no more than 50 kids will be eating at any time. Food service will have a plan for the system.

We will not be serving dinner.

Will be dismissed in a staggered fashion as well.

Perhaps they could have non-school sanction section gatherings (10-15 max)

Uniforms – the issue is the sizing and fitting of the uniforms. Will consider using secondary uniforms instead of the uniforms for the earlier part of the season. A final determination has not been made.

Don't need the uniforms until we start competing.

All the music is written, and first movement of drill is completed.

There will be a small group of kids playing for graduation 8-10 kids.
