1. Old Business

- I. <u>Spaghetti Dinner:</u> Scheduled for March 21, 2023. Silent auction items needed. Alicia has list from last year to reach out to those business again. Need to price out food and aim at approximately 200 people (as food ran out last year). Stacey to look into printed tickets this year using same company as we did for the raffle. Need volunteers to help with serving food. Ticket price will be \$10 with children under 5 free. Need a game plan in place by next booster meeting.
- II. <u>Band Festivals:</u> Pre-festival for 7/8th grade is 2/14 and 2/15 for high school. Solo/Ensemble is 2/11 in Imlay City. 31 events entered with an AM preference for performances. There are two percussion ensembles and the trailer will be needed. That schedule should be made available by next week. Will attended the Winter MSBOA meeting. They will be sending schedules for the Band Festival at Swartz Creek by the end of the week. As this is a multi-day event, will check to see if we can leave the band trailer there overnight.

2. New Business

- I. Lock-In: Presented by the band council. A fun night for band members to enjoy! Tentatively scheduled for January 28th from 6-11p.m. 8th graders will be invited to participate. They will have a curfew at 10pm allowing the highschoolers to have the last hour to themselves. Event will cost \$10 per ticket that will cover 2 slices of pizzas/2 breadsticks, drinks and all planned activities. They will primarily use the A wing and have different activities in each room i.e. movie playing in band room, video games in cafeteria, bounce house(\$250 through Appleseed rentals in Clio) in AUX gym with hourly activities planned for the main gym (dodgeball). Ryan put together a budget. With cost of ticket, a minimum of 37 tickets need to be sold to break even. They are expecting >90 students to participate. This fundraiser will go towards the band council fund. They will need at least 10 parent volunteers to help run/monitor. They are planning to have a pot luck for additional snacks. Band Council will create a Google Form to post for parent volunteers. Per Will, if we do not have sufficient parent volunteers, event cannot happen. Will to get facilities approved and Ryan to finalize paperwork for submission to the school as this is a fundraiser event.
